Would having more information about the legal system help you to better support your clients?

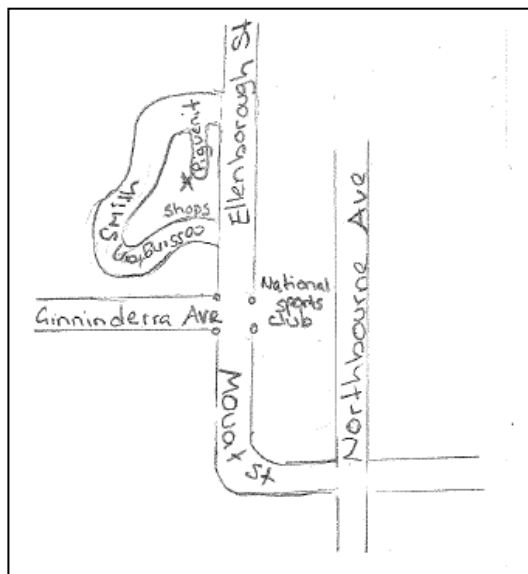
The Women's Legal Centre is holding a series of legal information sessions over the next 12 months.
